



## Nuclear Quality and Nuclear Safety Culture Policy

Management of Allweld commits that Nuclear and conventional safety is the overriding priority of the company and commits to establish, implement, comply with, review, and continuously improve the Integrated Management System, which is compliant with ISO 9001 & 19443, ISO 45001, IAEA GSR Part 2, ASME NQA-1, RD-0034, QN-100 Generic and Appendix A, ISO 3834, and other nuclear and non-nuclear requirements. This Nuclear Policy is extended and enhanced by the Allweld Occupational Health and Safety Policy ANI-POL-002 to achieve high nuclear quality and safety performance, and strong nuclear and occupational safety cultures.

Management will demonstrate through leadership, commitment and active involvement the following:

- Providing quality nuclear and non-nuclear services and manufacturing of components to full customer satisfaction by ensuring compliance with nuclear standards and nuclear safety requirements,
- Fostering a strong nuclear safety culture to ensure nuclear quality and nuclear safety is enhanced through the Safety Culture Enhancement Programme (SCEP) and not compromised by other priorities,
- Determining customer requirements, needs, and expectations and through communication ensure that they are understood and met,
- Setting and reviewing nuclear quality, safety, and safety culture objectives and provide necessary resources to achieve them,
- Provision of effective training and development of all employees and contract workers to implement and perform to nuclear requirements with the required attention to detail, and
- Enhancing safety and protection of workers, public, and environment from any form of radiation hazards, and
- The provision of non-nuclear related services and products will comply with customer requirements, applicable codes, standards, regulations, and relevant IMS requirements including best practices.

This Policy will be communicated, understood and applied throughout Allweld by all employees and contract workers to ensure safe and healthy working environments and that products and services meet all customer requirements, applicable codes, standards and regulatory requirements.
